Power to the youngsters?

A number of ambitious young challengers, aged 4 or 5, are taking up the challenge against their elders. Just Love You, Krack Time Atout, Josh Power, Kana de Beylev and Just A Gigolo all have great potential.

Revenge and Redemption

Sweden's **San Moteur** returns with a fight to settle. Björn Goop's talented trotter dominated the **Prix du Bourbonnais** last year but was sidelined with an injury before the Finals. Now back on the scene, **San Moteur** seeks to reclaim his moment of glory. Joining him are **Don Fanucci Zet**, his stablemate, and **Banderas Bi**, trained by the renowned Alessandro Gocciadoro of Italy.

And the outsiders?

While the likes of **Hooker Berry**, **Ampia Mede SM**, and others may be favored, this Group II promises a thrilling contest. Seasoned and on top form are contenders like **Idéal Ligneries**, **Ganay de Banville**, **Inmarosa**, and **Hokkaido Jiel**, who all have potential to upset the favorites, adding another layer of intrigue to the race.



Will energy prevail over experience?

A generation shift may be in sight as several ambitious young horses, aged 4 or 5, enter the scene. **Just Love You**, **Krack Time Atout**, **Josh Power**, **Kana de Beylev**, and **Just A Gigolo** possess tremendous potential and shouldn't be underestimated.
